Expressed in cells lacking fibronectin.

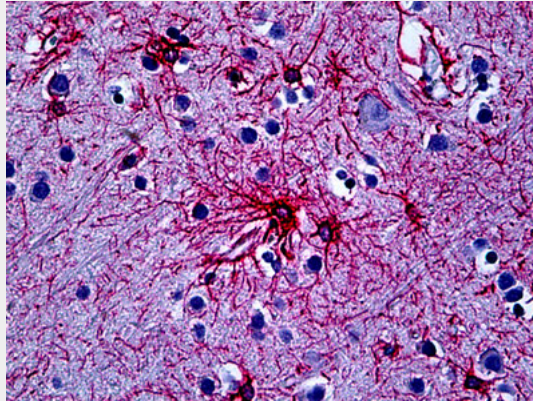
