**Target/Specificity**

This HIF1AN antibody is generated from rabbits immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic peptide between 23-54 amino acids from the N-terminal region of human HIF1AN.

**Dilution**

**Format**

Purified polyclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is prepared by Saturated Ammonium Sulfate (SAS) precipitation followed by dialysis against PBS.

**Storage**

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

**HIF1AN Antibody (N-term) - Protein Information**

**Name** HIF1AN

**Synonyms** FIH1

**Function** Hydroxylates HIF-1 alpha at 'Asn-803' in the C-terminal transactivation domain (CAD). Functions as an oxygen sensor and, under normoxic conditions, the hydroxylation prevents interaction of HIF-1 with transcriptional coactivators including Cbp/p300-interacting transactivator. Involved in transcriptional repression through interaction with HIF1A, VHL and histone deacetylases. Hydroxylates specific Asn residues within ankyrin repeat domains (ARD) of NFKB1, NFKBIA, NOTCH1, ASB4, PPP1R12A and several other ARD-containing proteins. Also hydroxylates Asp and His residues within ARDs of ANK1 and TNKS2, respectively. Negatively regulates NOTCH1 activity, accelerating myogenic differentiation. Positively regulates ASB4 activity, promoting vascular differentiation.

#### Cellular Location

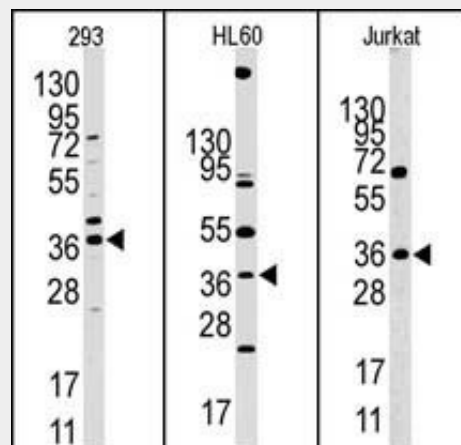
Nucleus. Cytoplasm. Cytoplasm, perinuclear region. Note=Mainly cytoplasmic localization, but interaction with NOTCH1 results in nuclear localization and interaction with ABPA3 results in perinuclear localization in macrophages

#### HIF1AN Antibody (N-term) - Background

FIH1Encoded protein (factor inhibiting HIF-1)is a co-repressor that interacts with hypoxia-inducible factor 1(HIF-1) alpha and the von Hippel-Lindau tumor suppressor protein to mediate repression of HIF-1 transcriptional activity.
