Regulates cell death by controlling the mitochondrial membrane permeability (PubMed: [11368354](http://www.uniprot.org/citations/11368354) target="_blank">11368354). Appears to function in a feedback loop system with caspases (PubMed: [11368354](http://www.uniprot.org/citations/11368354) target="_blank">11368354). Inhibits caspase activity either by preventing the release of cytochrome c from the mitochondria and/or by binding to the apoptosis-activating factor (APAF-1) (PubMed: [11368354](http://www.uniprot.org/citations/11368354) target="_blank">11368354). Also acts as an inhibitor of autophagy: interacts with BECN1 and AMBRA1 during non-starvation conditions and inhibits their autophagy function (PubMed: [18570871](http://www.uniprot.org/citations/18570871) target="_blank">18570871, PubMed: [20889974](http://www.uniprot.org/citations/20889974) target="_blank">20889974, PubMed: [21358617](http://www.uniprot.org/citations/21358617) target="_blank">21358617). May attenuate inflammation by impairing NLRP1-

inflammasome activation, hence CASP1 activation and IL1B release (PubMed:17418785).

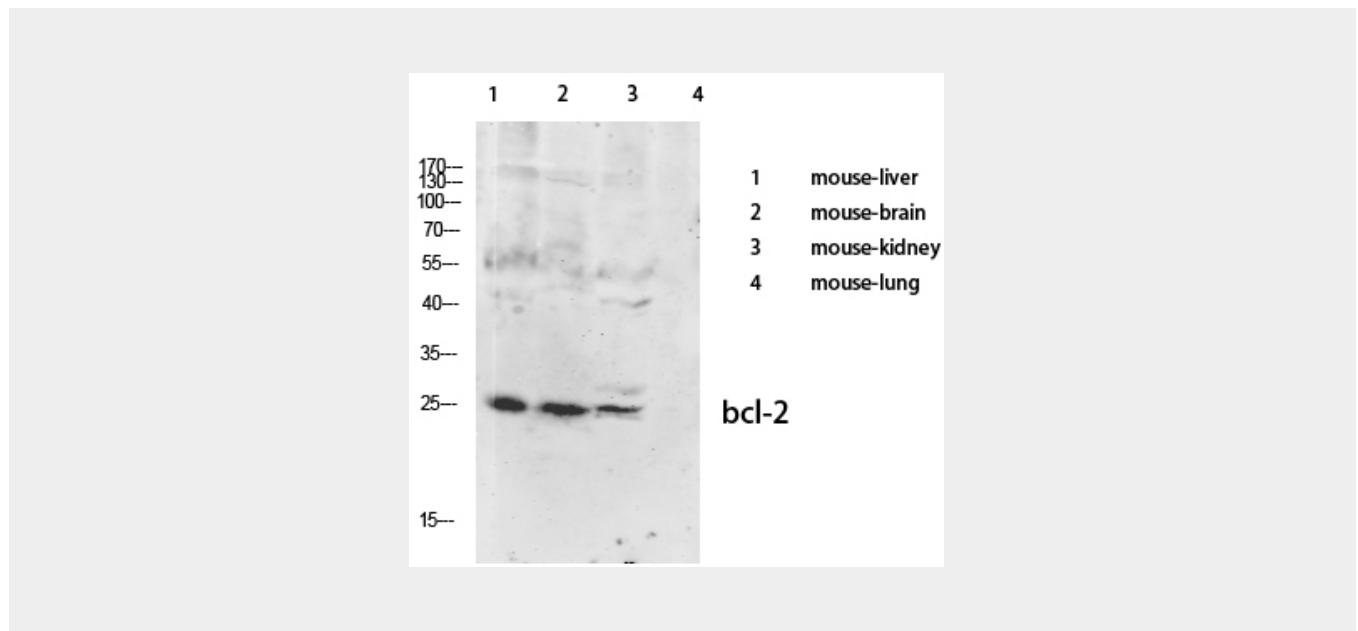
