Phosphorylates MAP2K1, and thereby activates the MAP kinase signal transduction pathway (PubMed:[21441910](http://www.uniprot.org/citations/21441910), PubMed:[29433126](http://www.uniprot.org/citations/29433126)). Phosphorylates PFKFB2 (PubMed:[36402789](http://www.uniprot.org/citations/36402789)). May play a role in the postsynaptic responses of hippocampal neurons (PubMed:[1508179](http://www.uniprot.org/citations/1508179)).

Nucleus. Cytoplasm. Cell membrane. Note=Colocalizes with RGS14 and RAF1 in both the cytoplasm and membranes.

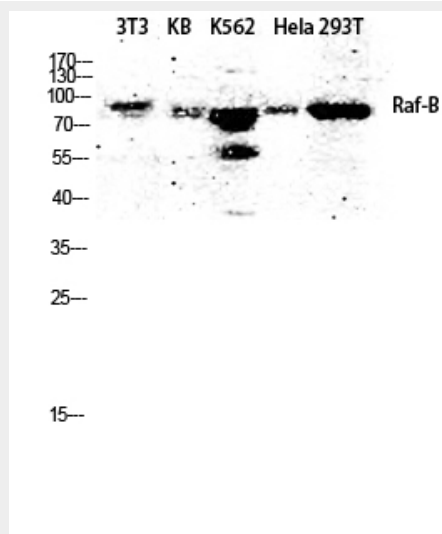
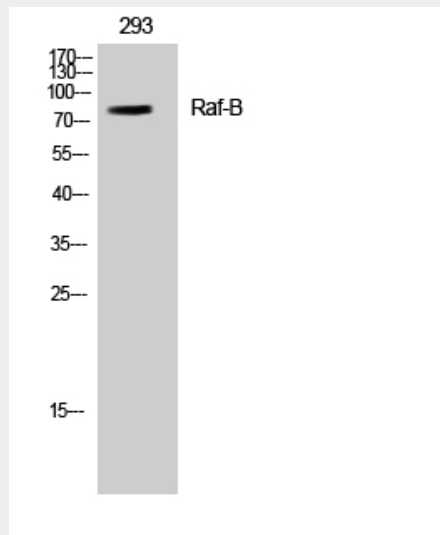
