This VARs antibody is generated from rabbits immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic peptide between 251-279 amino acids from the N-terminal region of human VARs.

**Format**

Purified polyclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is prepared by Saturated Ammonium Sulfate (SAS) precipitation followed by dialysis against PBS.

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

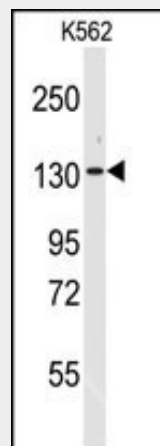

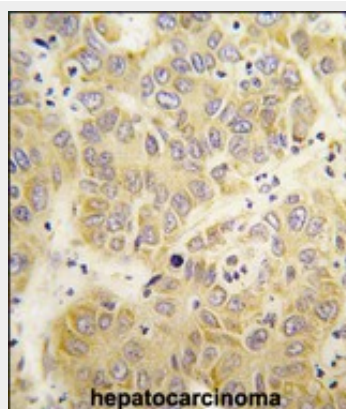

### **VARs Antibody (N-term) - Images**



Western blot analysis of anti-VARS Antibody (N-term) (Cat.#AP7843a) in K562 cell line lysates (35ug/lane). VARS (arrow) was detected using the purified Pab.



Formalin-fixed and paraffin-embedded human hepatocarcinoma tissue reacted with the VARS antibody (N-term) (Cat.#AP7834a), which was peroxidase-conjugated to the secondary antibody, followed by DAB staining. This data demonstrates the use of this antibody for immunohistochemistry; clinical relevance has not been evaluated.

### **VARs Antibody (N-term) - Background**

Aminoacyl-tRNA synthetases catalyze the aminoacylation of tRNA by their cognate amino acid. Because of their central role in linking amino acids with nucleotide triplets contained in tRNAs, aminoacyl-tRNA synthetases are thought to be among the first proteins that appeared in evolution. This protein belongs to the class-I aminoacyl-tRNA synthetase family and is located in the class III region of the major histocompatibility complex.
