This antiserum against Human MIP-1a has been tested for use in ELISA of human MIP-1a found in cell supernatants or in

plasma or serum. In ELISA formats and other immunoreactive assays, this

antibody will recognize recombinant and native human MIP-1a present in body fluids and cell supernatants. This

antiserum has not been evaluated for its ability to stain human MIP-1a in tissue sections, nor for its ability to neutralize human MIP-1a in bioassays, nor for its performance in immunoblot analysis. Reactivity in other immunoassays is

unknown.

The whole rabbit serum was prepared by repeated immunizations with recombinant

human MIP-1a produced in E.coli.

#### **Purity**

This antiserum has been heated to 56° C for 30 minutes.

#### **Storage Condition**

Store vial at -20° C prior to opening. Aliquot contents and freeze at -20° C or below for extended storage. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.

#### **Function**

Monokine with inflammatory and chemokinetic properties. Binds to CCR1, CCR4 and CCR5. One of the major HIV-suppressive factors produced by CD8+ T-cells. Recombinant MIP-1-alpha induces a dose- dependent inhibition of different strains of HIV-1, HIV-2, and similar immunodeficiency virus (SIV).
