Function

Docking protein which plays a central coordinating role for tyrosine kinase-based signaling related to cell adhesion (PubMed:12432078, PubMed:12832404). Implicated in induction of cell migration and cell branching (PubMed:12432078, PubMed:12832404, PubMed:17038317). Involved in the BCAR3-mediated inhibition of TGFB signaling (By similarity).

Cellular Location

Cell junction, focal adhesion. Cytoplasm Cell projection, axon {ECO:0000250|UniProtKB:Q61140} Note=Unphosphorylated form localizes in the cytoplasm (By similarity) Localizes to focal adhesion

sites following integrin engagement (By similarity). {ECO:0000250|UniProtKB:Q61140}

Tissue Location

Expressed in B-cells (at protein level) (PubMed:9020138). Widely expressed with an abundant expression in the testis (PubMed:10639512). Low level of expression seen in the liver, thymus, and peripheral blood leukocytes (PubMed:10639512)
